TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1.1 To promote awareness and understanding of the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty for the purposes for which it was designated.
- 1.2 To advise the local authorities and other bodies on countryside conservation, informal recreation and environmental management issues affecting the AONB.
- 1.3 To advise on the preparation and implementation of a Management Plan for the AONB.
- 1.4 To consider and offer advice on development plan policies, proposals and reviews insofar as they relate to the AONB.
- 1.5 To act as a forum for the discussion of major issues affecting the character of the AONB and, where appropriate, make recommendations.
- 1.6 To agree and monitor an annual programme of work, within resources made available by the constituent bodies and others.
